The Panel will discuss recent economic and legal issues, e.g. China's one-belt-one-road (land and sea silk road) policy and maritime issues, South Korea's intention to set up a specialist maritime court, Indonesia's new maritime policies (reversal of cabotage, new maritime routes joining the islands), etc.  The Panel will also explore whether there are any areas in which there can or should be unification of maritime law.

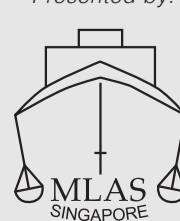
