The Singapore Institute of Arbitrators (SIArb) is pleased to announce that the annual International Entry Course is now open for registration. Candidates who pass the Course may, subject to satisfying other relevant criteria, qualify for admission as a Member of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators.

SYNOPSIS OF THE COURSE

The International Entry Course consists of 4 Modules conducted over two full days (27 & 28 April 2018). Each Module covers a particular segment of arbitration law and practice. Module 1 gives an overview of arbitration and introduces key concepts, rules and legislation. Module 2 covers the commencement of arbitration, and issues concerning constitution, jurisdiction and powers of the tribunal. Module 3 goes into the arbitration procedure, from statements to the substantive hearing. Module 4 discusses the award, and the steps that may be taken to challenge or enforce the award.

A candidate may apply to sit for only some of the Modules. Successful completion of all the course modules (with 100% attendance) and assessments will lead to qualification for membership as Member of SIArb, subject to satisfying other qualifying requirements.

Mr. Naresh Mahtani, FSIArb, FCIArb, Snr. Acc.Spec. (Building & Construction) SAL, has been in legal practice for over 30 years, in dispute resolution, commercial transactions, construction and oil & gas projects. He was a founding partner of ATMD Bird & Bird LLP and is currently a partner of Eldan Law LLP with an active practice in projects and dispute resolution. He was Chairman of the Society of Construction Law, Singapore (2006-2008) and is Honorary Secretary of SIArb. He has been counsel in various domestic and international arbitrations and litigations in Singapore and the region; and appointed as arbitrator in various institutional and ad hoc arbitration cases. He is on the SIAC, ICC, HKIAC, KLRCA and several other international arbitration panels; on the Disputes Resolution Panel of Singapore

Wholesale Electricity Market; Adjudicator with Financial Industry Dispute Resolution (FidreC), as well as Adjudicator and associate mediator with the Singapore Mediation Centre. He has written widely and been a speaker at various conferences on subjects relating to arbitration, expert determination and other progressive forms of ADR; and has been course director, lectured and tutored at the SIArb IEC and FAC courses for several years.



Mr. Chia Chor Leong is a lawyer who has been in legal practice for more than 37 years, specializing in litigation, arbitration and alternative dispute resolution. His main areas of expertise are in contract and construction law. He is a Senior Adjudicator accredited by Singapore Mediation Centre, and has had more than 10 years of experience as an adjudicator under the Building and Construction Industry Security of Payment Act (Cap 30B). He has acted as adjudicator (and as review adjudicator) in more than 70 adjudications (including adjudication reviews) to-date, and has written and issued more than 60 Adjudication Determinations (including Adjudication Review Determinations) to date. He is on the panel of arbitrators of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators, Singapore International Arbitration Centre, The Law Society Arbitration Scheme, and the Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration. Chor Leong is also a

Senior Mediator on the panel of The Law Society Mediation Scheme, and an Associate Mediator accredited by the Singapore Mediation Centre. He is a Fellow of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators and a member of its Council. He had taught at the International Entry Course and Fellowship Assessment Course of previous years, and is the Course Director of the International Entry Course 2018.



Mr. Francis Goh is an equity partner of Eversheds Harry Elias LLP. He is the head of the firm's International Arbitration Practice and he also leads the firm's Private Client practice.
