About the Talk:

It is not uncommon for parties to communicate with potential arbitrators before their appointment. Practically, this would be done so as to determine the availability of the candidate, e.g. that there is no conflict of interest in accepting appointment. It is not unusual for parties to ask for the CV, experience or other information relating the candidate. In principle, a degree of communication should be permitted. However, how far may the communications go?

That is the question.

Mr. Andrew Chan is a Partner in Litigation & Dispute Resolution and Joint Deputy Head of the Corporate Restructuring and Insolvency Practice Group of Allen & Gledhill LLP. His practice encompasses commercial work, and is a specialist in dispute resolution (especially arbitration), trusts, and insolvency (corporate and personal).
