Culture shock - lawyers are not all the same.

A tribunal is required to conduct hearings in a manner that is fair and gives each party a full opportunity to present its case. This is challenging where parties' counsel come from a variety of different legal traditions as is often the case in international arbitrations. This talk will consider some of the challenges and seek discussion on how hearings can be held in a manner that addresses these challenges.
