In particular, Samuel will be discussing the changes in the organizational structure of SIAC brought about by the establishment of the SIAC Court of Arbitration and the improvements made to the rules in relation to commencement of arbitrations, jurisdictional challenges, challenges to appointment of arbitrators and SIAC's publication of redacted arbitral awards.

Samuel graduated with a Bachelor of Laws (LL.B.) (Hons) from the University of Malaya, and a Master of Laws (LL.M.) from the Columbia University School of Law as a Fulbright and Harlan Fiske Stone Scholar. At Columbia, Samuel was also a W. Bayard Cutting Jr. Fellow and recipient of the CIMB Regional Scholarship and Parker School Certificate in Foreign and Comparative Law.
